St Michael's Church Hall is open on Wednesdays from 2-4pm

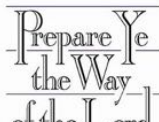

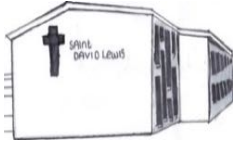
**Anyone willing** to Ferry the elderly to and from the Christmas Party on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> January please contact a member of the SVP.
