"Glorify the Lord with me. Together let us praise his name. I sought the Lord and he answered me; from all my terrors he set me free"

These words find themselves tucked in amongst the responsorial psalm of this weekend's Mass; and, if we are not careful, they can easily pass us by unawares. The responsorial psalm begins with an exhortation to 'bless the Lord at all times'. All that we are, and everything that we have, comes as a gift from the Lord, and gives rise for us to lift up our hearts in thanksgiving, and so blessing the Lord at all times. In living lives of praise and thanksgiving to Almighty God, the psalmist reminds us that He will free us from those fears, those 'terrors' that can entrap us. We are invited to hand ourselves over to the Lord, and trust.

I find myself reflecting upon this after recently celebrating my first year as a priest. It's truly been a time of immense blessing and privilege, as well as one of the most challenging and difficult things that I have ever done - it's certainly been a massive learning curve over this last year. At a funeral last week, the funeral director asked me if priesthood is all that I thought it was. And my simple answer to him was, no. One of the greatest joys and privileges has been being able to extend the healing hand of the Lord on to penitents in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, or to be able to enter into the lives of so many families and walk with them during their most vulnerable moments. I am sure that I have mentioned to some that I have been celebrating Mass since I was three or four years old, and so being able to celebrate Mass with the various communities has been a great joy. At the same time, as you can imagine, there have been moments which seminary doesn't prepare you for.

"I sought the Lord and he answered me; from all my terrors he set me free". The priesthood is not what I thought it was going to be because it is far more difficult that I could have ever imagined, or ever prepared myself for. At the same time, however, it's so much better than I could ever have imagined; it is truly the most amazing gift from the Lord, and I would not take back a single moment. This responsorial psalm from today's Mass is a gentle reminder to me to bless the Lord at all times, always thanking Him for His wonderful graces and blessings.
