The first reading speaks of the gathering of the tribes of Israel together at Shechem. A small detail, which can be so easily overlooked, is that Shechem is the place of the covenant. Their gathering is important. Rather than gathering for worship, the people are given an ultimatum through Joshua - they are to make a choice: either to serve the Lord, or to abandon the Lord and the things He has done, in favour of other gods; the other gods they wish to serve. In their answer, the people renew that covenant which they made with the Lord: "We have no intention of deserting the Lord our God and serving other gods".

We too, are also invited to make a choice: to either serve Almighty God, whose Son became flesh and dwells among us, or to serve other gods. In very real terms, this is a matter of life and death. Today, 'serving other gods' can take on many and varied manifestations: from the misuse of money or power, to those addictions which we would rather no one knew about.

As we examine our own lives, the question becomes for us: "Lord, to whom shall we go?" Renewing our covenant to 'serve the Lord' is important, and has consequences. The service we seek to offer to Almighty God doesn't begin at the 'stuff' we do - this is the sin of activism; it begins with who we are, as children of a loving Father. This is the foundation of our faith, our relationship with God the Father, and also our relationship with each other. Our reception of Holy Communion - the new renewal of that covenant - cannot make sense without this.

Our first reading from Joshua could be the prompting that we need to reflect upon this choice in our own lives - to serve the Lord, or to abandon the Lord in favour of other gods. Our reading gives rise to an opportunity, to the renewal of our own covenant relationship with the Lord.
