### **Moral Code or Living Faith?**

The Ten Commandments are the foundation of the Moral teaching of God's chosen people; the Moral Teachings of the Church ultimately find their root in them. They are not a moral code imposed to oppress; nor are they open to review with the moving of the times. The values they protect are the mark of a people with a unique vocation: holy, beloved and set apart. To live them out is to demonstrate to the world what it means to be fully human as the Creator intended.

The Commandments are not easily lived out. The people of Israel constantly wavered in fidelity to God and the Commandments. By the time Jesus came, God's Chosen People had fallen far from the mark God had marked for them. As a reminder, Jesus unpacked the Commandments further and placed an emphasis on intent, the stirrings of the heart, not just the acts themselves (Mt 5:17-48). It is only in a prayerful, loving relationship with God that true fidelity is possible. So, when Jesus turned the money changers' tables he was making a clear point ... no more business as usual; no more taking a casual approach to religion. He was saying NOW is the time for living faith; his zeal for God's house consumed him, and it is a zeal he wants us to share.

Lent is an opportunity for a gut-check. Has our religion become cold routine, no more than convictions and rituals like the Pharisees? Or are we more like Herod where our piety is more a monument to myself than to God? As temples of the Holy Spirit we are God's House here and now, and it is time for a clear out.

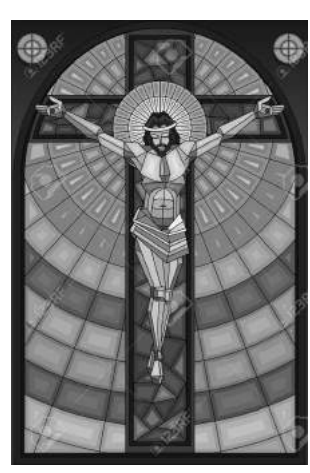

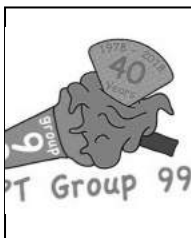

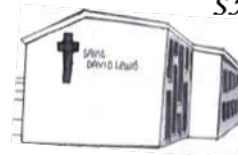
