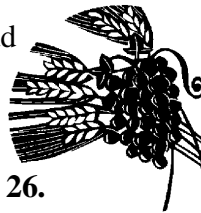

Sacred Signs

The month of June is dedicated to the Holy Eucharist and as Catholics we are invited to enter more closely into the mystery of the Sacrifice that is the Mass. Since the Second Vatican Council, the Church constantly refers to the 'priesthood of all the faithful'. This priesthood is distinct from the priesthood that Father Daniel and myself exercise. The entire Liturgy of the Mass is an expression of the priesthood of all who are gathered with the ministerial priesthood of the priest himself acting as bridge between God and humanity. Over the course of this month we will look at our common priesthood in the various parts of the Mass.

The Mass is meant to engage the senses from the moment we walk through the door of the church. How we enter the church has a direct effect on how we enter the Mass and exercise our priesthood. As you approach the door of the church bear in mind that you approach Christ "the door", our access to the Father, who "stands and knocks" (Rev 3:20) awaiting our entry. We should walk through the door of the church and "go within his gates, giving thanks ... enter his courts with songs of praise" (Ps 100:4). And when we enter the door we make the sign of the Cross with the holy water. By doing so we recall that we are created by the Most Holy Trinity and nourished by the God-given grace that flows from the Cross, which is our mark and our protection. By the Cross we are transported to heaven; as we walk through the door we come to the place where heaven touches earth.

Once through the door we genuflect, not to some finely decorated box, but to the God who lies within. "... every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth ..." (Phil 2:10). Then we sit or kneel in silence and commune with Him, the first and the last, the beginning and the end of all, as we prepare our hearts for the Mass to begin. And when the Mass begins we lay before him our faults and Collect all our thoughts, or hopes and our fears together as the priest says "Let us pray ...". And in the silence that follows that invite place before Him our intentions; and the Mass proper begins..

Yesterday at St. David's Cathedral Father Robert James was ordained to the priesthood by Archbishop George. Many of you will remember Robert as a seminarian who spent a Holy Week placement within the parish two years ago.

Father Robert's ordination marks the first of three to the priesthood this summer. Peter Davies and Nick Williams will be ordained in the coming weeks and Laurence Bryce will be ordained to the Diaconate in two weeks time. Please pray for all our students and more vocations within our diocese.

It also brings me great joy to tell you that the new Father Robert James has been appointed assistant priest here at All Saints in addition to Father Daniel. Father Robert will begin his ministry with us in September.

****THE LAW HAS CHANGED IN THE EU AND IT AFFECTS PARISH REGISTRATION****

On May 25th 2018 the Data Protections Laws in the U.K. change as we adopt the new European Laws known as "GDPR". The rules are becoming tighter and where they didn't affect the Church too badly in the past; the Church will now have to enter full compliance. Following legal advice, apart from information that has to be kept by law, and entries within the church registers, **we will have to destroy all data we hold on our parishioners and start from scratch.** This means all data including names, addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses etc. held either centrally in the parish office or in our communities will have to be destroyed to ensure your data is held in one place (a system) and only utilised by those who need access to fulfil official roles **provided you have given your consent.**

We now begin a parish census. **All parishioners will need to complete the census to be officially registered with the parish.** Along with the census form you will also have access to a consent form which **must be completed by everyone named on the census (one consent form per person).** I am reliant on all communities to pull together to ensure the sick and housebound and even the lapsed who want to be recognised as part of the parish will take part.

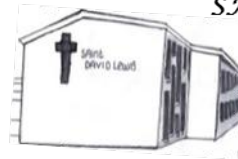
