**‘This IS’ ... ‘I AM’ ... ‘The Body of Christ’ ... ‘AMEN’
The power of words**

Words are powerful things. By our words our beliefs and our feelings can be made known in subconscious ways. We can be held to account by our words in a court of law. Our words can define or break our relationship with others. This is why the Lord warns us to choose our words carefully and only ever use words that ‘build up’.

One of the defining words of our Catholic belief is ‘*Transubstantiation*’; our belief that, in our celebration of the Mass, the bread and wine are actually transformed into Jesus Christ - Body, Blood, Soul & Divinity. In our discussions with people who would talk about our belief in the Eucharist, the word ‘Remembrance’ is often held up as the argument against our belief in the Real Presence. If we are to truly understand the meaning of “Do this in remembrance of me” we have to look carefully at the word ‘remembrance’.

In the original Greek texts of the Gospel the word *anamnesis* is what has been translated into ‘remembrance’. It’s not very accurate as *anamnesis* goes a lot further than just remembering. Our limited language has no comparable word hence translators have chosen a close approximation. *Anamnesis* is a ritualistic term that means in the act of remembering we are carried back to the original event and its effects. Our Lord practiced the Jewish faith, a faith that is very ritualistic and to whom *anamnesis* makes perfect sense. So when Jesus said “Do this in remembrance of me” he invited us in the Eucharist, to literally join him at the foot of Calvary; to be drawn into the event and it’s saving effects. At our celebration of the Eucharist, the Mass, we re-member (draw together) Christ’s Body, the Church, through our act of receiving His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in Holy Communion.

“I AM the bread of life” – bread is basic sustenance for life even by today’s standards. Jesus is all we need to enter through to the Kingdom of Heaven and Eternal Life.

“The Body of Christ” – This IS Jesus, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity.

“AMEN” – “I believe” that this is Christ truly present to me in the Blessed Sacrament, who I am about to consume in this celebration of the Eucharist, and adore each time I come into His presence at the tabernacle or in Eucharistic Adoration. And “I believe” everything He teaches me through the Scriptures and through the teaching of His Church, the Catholic Church. And therefore I am part of His Body in Communion with all those around me in this place, and throughout the entire Catholic Church; we are ONE community – a body, who are universal, being made holy and founded on apostolic foundations.
