**'To Love God; To Love Our Neighbour; To Make Disciples'** is the Mission to which Jesus calls us all. The dismissal at Mass to "Go forth ..." is not simply a 'Go now, go home'; it is a constant reminder of the 'Great Commission' Jesus has given us as his Church (Matthew 28:19-20). At Baptism we were called to be saints and in 'going forth' with a zeal for God and zeal for souls we are made more like the saints who are conformed to the image of Christ.

In 2007, six churches came together as an echo/an image of the Communion of Saints. Today that Communion grows as we welcome St. Gabriel's, St. Julius the Martyr and Ss. Julius, Aaron and David to the fold. Just like the Communion of Saints we unite together with a threefold purpose **'To Love God; To Love Our Neighbour; To Make Disciples'**.

As we take up this mantle anew, we set off on our journey together with this new newsletter format. This is an exciting time for us as the Communion of Saints in Newport and this newsletter has been designed to focus our response to the threefold call. Great things are possible as boundaries are dropped and we pool our gifts and talents in service of the Kingdom of God.

We also welcome Fr. Robert James and Fr. Peter McLaren as we set off on our new venture. I ask you also to pray for Fr. Roman Kowalski who's arrival has been delayed due to the sudden illness of his mother. He will join us in the coming weeks but please keep Mrs Kowalski in your prayers. And please be assured of our prayers as we move forward together and "Go forth ..."
