On 1st October 1884 Pope Leo XIII had a mystical experience at Mass. He stood transfixed at the altar looking pale and fearful. When he came back to the world around him he went to his office and wrote down a prayer, which he decreed should be said at the end of every Mass. That prayer is the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel that we recite in All Saints after weekday Mass, and every Mass in St. Michael's.

Pope Leo later told his private secretary that as he stood at the altar he had a vision of demons gathering around Rome. Over the years conjecture has added that the Pope heard two voices, Satan and the Lord Jesus. Satan boasted that he could destroy the Church in 75 or 100 years if given the opportunity. Then the Lord gave him permission to try just as he did with Job (See Job chapter 1).

The vision we know to be true from the words of Pope Leo himself; the conversation less so. What remains is that Satan will do his utmost to destroy the Church any way he can, because the Church is the means of Salvation. **You and I are the Church**, Satan is out to deceive and destroy us as best he can. Our life is ordered towards eternal things as the prophet Daniel reminds us. The prayer to St. Michael was removed from the end of Mass; St. John Paul II told us not to forget it and encouraged its use; and now in the current climate bishops around the world are slowly reintroducing it. **St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in Battle**
