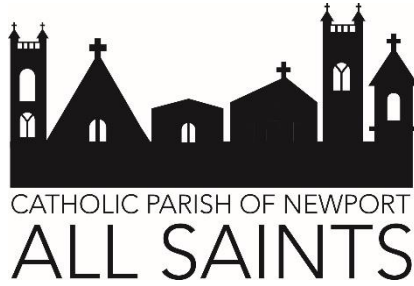

Divine Mercy SOS - Jesus, I trust in You!

One of the great privileges of being a priest is entering into the lives of so many people at their most important moments; moments of joy and thanksgiving at the birth of a child, perhaps, or amongst the sadness and grief of a family who has lost someone they love and cherish. One such significant moment is to attend the bedside of someone entering the final stage of their earthly journey, and to prepare them for the next part of their journey through the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Anointing of the Sick; to be able to say with confidence and conviction: "May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up".

Our Blessed Lord revealed to St. Faustina of the Divine Mercy devotion: "**At the hour of their death, I defend as My own glory every soul that will say this chaplet; or when others say it for a dying person, the indulgence is the same**". As we continue to pray for those people of our parish community who are sick or housebound, Our Lord desires that those reaching 'the hour of their death' be prayed for in a particular way. St. Faustina calls it "the critical hour".

With such an important link as we have with the hospitals, we have established a Divine Mercy SOS group. Once registered, you will be contacted by one of the priests with the first name of someone who has reached that 'critical hour', who very often will have received anointing from the priest. We ask that you pray the chaplet for that particular person.

Advent Journey

Advent comes from the Latin word meaning, 'coming'. During Advent, we have the opportunity to prepare for Jesus' coming: it is a season of joy and expectation. We have opportunities to prepare for the joyous season of Christmas.

Mornings of Recollection

On the Saturdays during Advent, there is the opportunity to participate in a morning of recollection, and spiritually prepare for the coming of the Lord. The format for Saturday morning will change slightly to accommodate this:

10:00am – Holy Mass

10:30am – Reflection on the theme of the day

11:10am – Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament

11:45am – Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament

The sacrament of Reconciliation will continue to be celebrated from 10:30am to 11:45am, as usual.
