"Listen, Israel..."

The first reading, from the book of Deuteronomy, contains one of the most important prayers of the Jewish people: the *Shema*, meaning 'Listen'. The prayer is an exhortation from Moses to the people to love and worship Almighty God alone. This prayer would be prayed by the Jewish people in the morning and in the evening, as they continue to consecrate their day to God. This same prayer is repeated on the lips of Jesus in today's Gospel.

We, as Christians, are called also to love and worship God alone. The sin of idolatry is not, unfortunately, confined to the scriptures or to the history books. Idolatry, in the twenty-first century, continues to present itself and manifest itself, so subtly that we so often do not recognise it. Examples can be challenging to us: wanting Mass to be as short as physically possible, for example; wanting to get the 'God bit' over with, so that it doesn't interfere with the rest of the weekend (something I recently overheard). Another example, made last year was that of sports matches on Sunday mornings. This, of course, despite the many other opportunities.

The *Shema* is a reminder to us to 'listen' to the voice of the Lord; to make that space on the Lord's day to worship Almighty God, to place the Lord at the very centre of our lives. The *Shema* is a reminder to us that the faith that we profess is relational; it's not about ticking off the obligations. Let the *Shema* prayer of the Jewish people become our prayer that these words may be written on our hearts.
