Entrance Antiphon:

Let my prayer come into your presence.
Incline your ear to my cry for help, O Lord.

This year we commemorate, we remember, that one hundred years ago the most brutal conflict in Europe came to an end. Europe was changed forever. Millions of souls, military and civilian were lost during the conflict. The widow in today's Gospel gave 'everything that she possessed' yet the people who died in the 'Great' War gave even more than her, they gave their very lives.

The question that arises is 'why?' Why was so much given? Why were so many lives lost? Never again, is what we are always told. Never again will there be so much bloodshed, never again will generations be lost. Yet we know that this 'never again' is just words. Today, we mark in a particular way the end of the First World War; and we also remember all those who have lost their lives in the conflicts that have happened since then: the Second World War, the Korean War, the Iraq Wars, the War in Afghanistan; so much given, so much lost.

*And now the Torch and Poppy Red
We wear in honor of our dead.
Fear not that ye have died for naught;
We'll teach the lesson that ye wrought
In Flanders Fields.*
