It is no accident that this week we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints (All Saints Day) followed immediately by the Commemoration of the All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day). On All Saints Day we give thanks to Almighty God for the many saints, some unknown to us, who enjoy the Beatific Vision – those men and women who have left this world and now live forever in God's presence, interceding for us who call upon them.

On All Souls Day we remember, in a special way, all those members of our families and our friends who have died; but we also remember those who have no one to pray for them. We remember all the souls in Purgatory, and we pray for them, we pray that they too may pass from Purgatory to Heaven. We pray for them, knowing that they are also praying for us.

This All Saints Day we should give thanks to God for the multitude of people through whom He has worked such great miracles. Through whom the Faith has been transferred to this generation. On this All Souls Day we should pray not only for our loved ones, but also those who have no one to pray for them. We should offer our prayers for those souls that need them.
