I'm sure most of us have sampled some pretty awful wine during the course of our lives. For those of us who enjoy the (occasional) tittle, we know that our inhibitions are lessened and that we do not care as much about the opinions of those who are around us – this, while being occasionally hilarious, can also be disastrous. However, avoiding the excesses, when taken in moderation wine can be a satisfying and warming tittle that has the positive effect of aiding digestion.

The Gospel for this Sunday speaks of the Lord's first miracle. The changing of water into wine. We do not doubt the historical accuracy of this passage of Sacred Scripture, but there is also another meaning to it, a deeper meaning. The Lord provides us with everything that we need. He also provides us with something fresh, and exciting. The Lord is the very embodiment of the love of God. As he offered to the wedding guests this wine, so he offers to all of us the 'wine' that is the love of God. This love, like a little wine, will gladden the heart. The wine that will make us sing. The psalms tell us to 'Sing and new song to the Lord'; St Augustine said that Christians sing this 'new song' and that this song is a 'thing of love' – the wine that we imbibe from the Lord, bring us joy, gladdens the heart, and allows us to love.
