There have been several complaints about people reading and sometimes discussing the contents of the Newsletter during Mass. This can be an unwelcome distraction to all. Parking @ St. Mary's - Please do not park in St Mary's Presbytery car park, or on the keep clear sign. The clergy have to be able to leave for Masses around the parish, and there have been several times in the last few weeks, that they have been blocked in by parishioners. Please, also be aware of parking on the hill, just on the bend of School Lane, it makes it very difficult to see traffic coming down the hill, as well being able to get around parked cars.

Congratulations

Last weekend we were blessed as a parish as a Church to welcome Edrick Campbell into full communion with the Catholic Church at St. Michael's. Edrick approached the waters of Baptism supported by his daughter Sarah. May God bless Edrick and Sarah in this new chapter of the life of faith.

A clarification regarding Baptism in All Saints

It has been brought to our attention in the past week that there is a false rumour doing the rounds regarding the Sacrament of Baptism within the parish. It is **not** true that there is a six-week preparation course; it is still two one-hour sessions. However the suggestion actually has merit as the Lord commanded "Go therefore make disciples ... baptise them ..." (Mt 28:19); the emphasis of the original Greek being we make disciples then baptise not baptise to make disciples. Pope Francis has also been making calls for more adequate preparation in a spirit of encounter.

That said, it IS true that Baptisms outside Mass now take place once a month **on a Saturday**. The clergy were recently told that there is no weekend cover available in the diocese for sickness and holidays and we are to support other parishes where needed. We can no longer guarantee a full complement of clergy on Sundays making the baptism schedule impossible; however, Baptisms on Saturday will work. As such, Baptisms outside Mass now take place on the last Saturday of the month at four of our churches simultaneously with up to four families at a time. That equates to 16 Baptisms outside Mass a month **increasing** the monthly total than under the previous provision. Please pray for the Pastoral Team as we prepare to hold a day of prayer and discussion on April 1st to look at more long-term future strategies for the parish and will assess how these new arrangements are operating, along with how we promote a spirit of encounter across the entire parish.

This weekend you will notice a booklet with this title included in the copies of the diocesan newspaper and at the back of our churches. The booklet has been produced by the diocese to help people make informed decisions when deciding to leave a legacy or bequest to the parish, a church or the diocese upon death. In recent years there has been a case within our parish where a parishioner died never updating their will, even though the individual parishes ceased to exist and 'All Saints' was formed. It has taken the executors of the will nearly four years to sort out the legal implications and have the wishes of the deceased realised.

Please read the leaflet carefully and take advice if you are considering leaving a lasting legacy to our Church, so that your wishes may be executed fully.
