Changes to Gift-Aid envelopes

April marks the start of a new financial year for all organisations; the Church is no different. Last week a letter was received by each of the Gift-Aid secretaries in our churches informing them of coming changes following a meeting requested by the Diocesan treasurer, Mr David Evans before Christmas.

As All Saints has grown, the task of our parish treasurer, Mr. John Wysome has also become more complex. The diocese is working with John to setup a new computerized financial system through the use of a package called 'Quickbooks'. The new system will enable John to easily manage the books for the entire parish affording a greater level of detail, and will aid Fr. Michael, the new parish Finance Committee and the diocese in the decision-making processes involved in running a parish.

With the implementation of the new system comes a new collection envelope for parishioners who Gift-Aid. If you currently receive envelopes to contribute to the offertory collection, **your number is about to change.** Across the nine churches 1,500 sets of envelopes were being ordered on an annual basis, where as in reality we have less than 500 people who Gift-Aid. The excesses was due to each church having its own envelope, minimum print runs, costs etc. associated with printing. From April there will be ONE 'All Saints' envelope and through the power of Quickbooks the Gift-Aid of each church will be tracked through the individual envelope number. So when you collect your new envelopes in the coming weeks, don't panic, a mistake hasn't been made, your number will have changed.

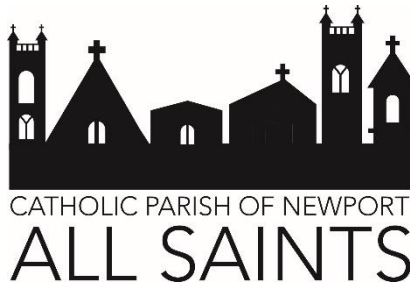

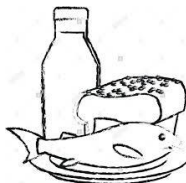

Being intentional on our Lenten journey

On Wednesday we begin our annual journey through the wilderness as we begin the holy season of Lent. Lent offers us all an opportunity to grow in our relationship with God and to deepen our commitment to a way of life, the way of intentional discipleship, which began with our baptism. In our busy world, Lent provides us with an opportunity to reflect upon our patterns, to pray more deeply, experience sorrow for what we've done and failed to do, and to be generous to those in need.

The Lenten works of prayer, fasting and almsgiving strengthen our resolve for discipleship and help lift the veil of selfishness from our eyes. (Intentional) Discipleship is the call of all the baptised. We are called to grow in holiness and bring the Good News of Jesus Christ to others through our daily lives. We can only truly do this by encountering our God who waits for us in the wilderness of our Lenten journey. The words of Ash Wednesday "*Remember you are dust and to dust you shall return*" remind us that one day we will be called to give an account of our discipleship. The cross the ashes make show that we are marked and chosen, each one by name.

Our almsgiving in the form of the Lenten Alms will again be dedicated to continue the work of the **Diocesan Refugee Project**.
