Parish Pilgrimage to the shrine of Our Lady of Penrhys – Saturday, 4th May 2019, departing Newport at 9:45am.

The pilgrimage will include Mass, Adoration, and the opportunity for the Sacrament of Reconciliation at the parish Church of Ss. Gabriel and Raphael, Tonypany, followed by lunch in the hall of the primary school. The pilgrimage will conclude with rosary and devotions on the mountain.

The shrine of Our Lady is situated in the heart of the Rhondda Valley, and dates back to the medieval period. Originally, Penrhys was part of the estate which belonged to the Cistercians of Llantarnam Abbey – a local connection for us!

Divine Mercy Sunday – 28th April 2019 - Jesus told St. Faustina that this Feast of Mercy would be a very special day when "*all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened*". (Diary 699) Our Lord made a great promise to all those souls who would go to Confession and then receive Him in Holy Communion on the Feast of Mercy, on the Sunday after Easter, which is now called Divine Mercy Sunday throughout the Catholic Church.

Our Lord promised that "*The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.*" (Diary 699) He went on to say "*I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy.*" (Diary 1109).

On this great feast of Mercy this year we will keep the Hour of Mercy in a particular way imploring God's Mercy on the British Isles. There will be the opportunity to experience God's Mercy in Confession during the Holy Hour, and an opportunity to venerate the relic of St. John Paul II, who as Pope, helped spread this great devotion across the world. **Join us at St. Mary's at 3.00pm with refreshments served afterwards.**
