**Parish Pilgrimage to the shrine of Our Lady of Penrhys
Saturday, 4th May 2019 departing
Newport at 9.45 am prompt**

Thank you to everyone who has registered to make the visit to the shrine. It is wonderful that a number of people from around the parish have registered to make the pilgrimage.

The sign-up sheets will be used as a check list at the start of our pilgrimage. Here is some information for the pilgrimage:



- The coach will leave from St. Mary's Church, Stow Hill at **9:45 am prompt**. This is to enable us to arrive at the parish of Ss. Gabriel and Raphael, Tonypandy, where we will be welcomed by local parishioners, who are joining us for the celebration of Mass at 11am.
- After Mass, there will be the opportunity to discover more about the shrine, and to venerate the statue in the Church.
- Fr. Daniel will make himself available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation during the pilgrimage.
- Please bring a packed lunch with you. Parishioners from Ss. Gabriel and Raphael have very kindly offered to provide teas and coffees for us.
- After lunch, we will take the coach to Penrhys itself, and to the shrine of Our Lady which overlooks the Rhondda valley. Here, we will have the rosary and devotions before the statue. I would recommend bringing a small, fold-up chair with you.
- We aim to return to Newport around 4:30pm.

There is minimal walking involved in this pilgrimage. The coach will take us to the places where we need to be. The cost for the pilgrimage will be **£10.00 per person**, which will cover the coach.

If you have a petition to take to the shrine, and are unable to come on our pilgrimage, please hand the petition into the parish office by **Friday, 3rd May**, and the pilgrim group will take them to the shrine. If you require any more information, please contact Fr. Daniel.

Divine Mercy Sunday

This Sunday

3.00 pm

In a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. The Lord expressed His will with regard to this feast in His very first revelation to St. Faustina. The most comprehensive revelation can be found in her *Diary* entry:

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine floodgates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy.

Divine Mercy devotions begin at St. Mary's THIS Sunday at 3.00pm, with the 3 O'Clock Prayer, chaplet of Divine Mercy, devotions, and veneration of the relic of St. John Paul II. If you have an image of the Divine Mercy, bring that along; there will be the solemn blessing of the image of the Divine Mercy at the conclusion of the Holy Hour.

Throughout the Holy Hour, there will be opportunity to experience the mercy of the Lord in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

May God continue to bless us all on the road ahead, and keep us all from chocolate tummy!
