Visit of Our Lady of Fatima and relics of the visionaries: the day is almost upon us!

This Monday (May 13th) the parish will be blessed by a visit of the pilgrim statue of Our Lady of Fatima along with relics of the visionaries. The statue will be at St. Mary's from 2:00pm-9:00pm. Do make every effort to visit the church on such a blessed day. The timetable for the event will be:

2:00pm – Welcome ceremony including procession of statue into the church with crowning and talk.

3:00pm – The Hour of Mercy (Divine Mercy Holy Hour)

4:00pm – 6:00pm – Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and an opportunity to visit the relics. Rosary to be recited every 30 minutes. Concluding with Benediction.

7:00pm – Mass in English for the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima

8:00pm – Mass in Polish for the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima

For those who have volunteered to be marshals for the day, if you haven't already spoken to or heard from Fr Michael, please contact the parish office on Monday morning, with your availability.

This weekend we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, this is because in the Gospel, Our Lord refers to himself as the shepherd, 'the sheep that belong to me listen to my voice.' We each listen to the call of the Lord in our own lives. It is why this weekend is also called 'Vocations Sunday' – Vocation comes from the Latin verb, *vocare*, to call.

For some of us the call from the Lord is to be married, for others to be single, and for others to enter the religious life. But for some, the Lord calls them to be priests.

Priests do not grow on trees; they are formed in seminaries. Just as priests do not grow on trees, so it is with the money needed to pay for the training. It costs around £28,000 per student a year, for 6 or 7 years. Presently we have 3 seminarians... I shall let you do the mental arithmetic!

Next weekend there will be a collection in support of the Priest's Training Fund – I ask that you give generously to this worthwhile cause. As well as supporting our seminarians financially, I would ask you to pray for them, and for more vocations to the priesthood in this diocese.
