We can often be guilty of limiting our celebration of Christian festivals to one day. As we know, Easter and Christmas both have Octaves; eight days during which we continue to celebrate the great solemnities. The Christmas season, and the Easter season, are both longer than eight days; traditionally Christmastide lasted until the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, the 2<sup>nd</sup> February. Eastertide continues until Pentecost.

The joy of the Risen Lord is something that should permeate our lives, not just for the eight days, but also for the whole of Eastertide, and beyond. Pope Francis is often telling us to share this joy with those we meet. He chastises those who walk around with sullen faces. The joy of the Risen Lord is something that we carry with us wherever we go.

What is this joy? It is that God loves you so much that He sent His only begotten Son into the world to die for you (cf John 3:16). He came as our Saviour and Redeemer.

Recently the parish had the great joy of welcoming six children into the Family of God: Tom, Lydia, Ella, William, Sofia and Ava – these are children who have chosen to be baptised. My prayer is that the encounter they have had with the Risen Lord is one from which they will continue to draw the grace and the strength they need – not just for eight days, but the whole of their lives.
