Announcement

Dear brothers and sisters,

As we draw closer to the celebration of Pentecost, we recall the constant action of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Church. The Spirit animates, brings life, peace and joy where He moves and hearts are open to receive Him. Two years ago, the Holy Spirit sent to Newport a young, fresh priest in Fr. Daniel Stanton. Fr. Daniel has brought life and joy to the Church here in Newport with his infectious laugh, deep spirituality and pastoral heart. Qualities that the Holy Spirit is now calling to pastures new.

This Summer Fr. Daniel will leave the Parish of All Saints, Newport and take on the role of Priest-in-Charge of Cardiff Cathedral (Metropolitan Cathedral Church of St David, Cardiff). This is an immense task, and one to which we know Fr. Daniel will rise. He will take with him the gifts with which the Holy Spirit has imbued him, but he will leave behind two years' worth of dedicated service in this portion of the Lord's Vineyard, service from which we have all benefited. As Priest-in-Charge of the Cathedral, Fr. Daniel will be responsible for the day-to-day running of the Cathedral on behalf of His Grace, who is Rector of the Cathedral. We will, of course organise a proper thanksgiving before his departure; details to follow.



Fr. Daniel's arrival at the Cathedral coincides with the departure of Canon Peter Collins. Canon Collins is to assume responsibility of the Parish of St Mary's Canton and Holy Family, Fairwater. Canon Collins is succeeding Mgr. John Maguire who is retiring, having served in the diocese for the last 52 years.



Fr. Daniel has been a very capable sous chef in the kitchen of the presbytery, and it is only right that he is succeeded by someone who will aid Fr Robert in not burning down the house. To that end, His Grace has appointed Deacon Laurence Bryce to the parish of All Saints, starting in September. Laurence will be ordained to the Priesthood at St David's Cathedral, on the 22nd June at 12noon. He will be familiar to a number of parishioners as he is one of the seminarians who has utilised the presbytery at St Anne's outside term-time.

As we continue our journey towards Pentecost, I invite all of you to pray to the Holy Spirit for Fr. Daniel, Canon Collins and Deacon Laurence as they prepare to embark on a new journey. I ask that you also pray for an increase in Vocations to the Priesthood and the Religious Life within the Archdiocese of Cardiff, but most especially from our own parish.

God loves a cheerful giver and we are blessed to have Fr. Daniel a short time longer as he cheerfully gives of his times and talents to our parish. Fr. Michael.
