PRESENTATION OF THE LORD (Cycle A)

2nd February 2020

"Let Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament speak to your hearts. It is he who is the true answer of life that you seek. He stays here with us: he is God with us. Seek him without tiring, welcome him without reserve, love him without interruption: today, tomorrow, forever". (St. John Paul II)

As we leave January and change creeps into our world once again, there is one constant that always remains i.e. the gift of Jesus Christ himself truly present in the Eucharist. He is the one on whom we can always depend, he is our rock, our fortress. The Eucharist is the quite literally the source and summit of our Christian life.
