PARISH MISSION UPDATE

The mission will explore the importance of the Eucharist in our day to day lives as Catholic Christians, and provide an opportunity to deepen our love for Christ and His Church by learning more about the beauty of Eucharistic Adoration.

Closing Mass - Monday 24th February at 7.00pm

Talk: Adoration at the foot of the Cross" – Monday 24th February at 7.45pm
