LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

This week, we had a stimulating meeting with the Archdiocese's Development (i.e. Fundraising) Team to discuss a three year project for which they have secured a grant from the Heritage Lottery Fund and entitled *Building Resilience – Safeguarding our Ecclesiastical Heritage*. The funding will enable the communities within and around four Grade II listed churches (St Michael's and St Mary's, Newport, St Dyfrig's, Treforest and Our Lady Queen of Peace, Newbridge) to explore how they can build their volunteer numbers, volunteer skills base and overall fundraising capacity to contribute to the long term strength and future of the churches.

The scheme provides a valuable opportunity to open up possible new avenues of funding – funding that might support both community activities and/or contribute to the costs of maintaining the fabric of the churches and their associated buildings. Given the £300,000 bill that is facing us in relation to the urgent repairs required at both St Michael's and St Mary's Churches, the meeting came at a prescient time.

As a starting point, the Archdiocesan Development Team is interested in talking to any parishioners who might be interested in taking an active role in this project. CURRICULUM AND ASSESSMENT (WALES) BILL

The Curriculum and Assessment (Wales) Bill currently before the Senedd will effectively remove the rights of parents as the first educators of their children to chose the right moment to discuss love and human sexuality with their

children. This will be overridden by the imposition of a curriculum not in conformity with Christian teaching (and that of many other faiths) and the right of parents to remove their children from such classes will be removed.

A week on Wednesday we begin the journey through the season of Lent with Ash Wednesday. The Holy See has issued guidelines on the distribution of Ashes in these times of pandemic. To ensure as many parishioners as possible have the opportunity to receive Ashes the distribution will be made available in the following ways:

Public Masses at St. Mary's: Masses with the Blessing & Distribution of Ashes will take place at **7.00am, 9.00am, 11.00am, 5.00pm & 7.00pm**. The Mass spaces will be first come first served

Drive thru Ashing points - the Distribution of Ashes will take place in the car parks of the following churches at these times:

8.15am-9.15am @ St. David's
10.30am – 11.30am @ St. Anne's
12.30-1.30pm @ St. Gabriel's

Walk up Distribution: a priest will be available on the quadrangle outside the doors of St. Michael's from 2.30pm-3.30pm

Alternatively, if you wish to receive ashes along with a simple service to use at home please contact the parish office so we can make arrangements to get the Ashes to you.
