CURRICULUM AND ASSESSMENT (WALES) BILL

The Curriculum and Assessment (Wales) Bill currently before the Senedd will effectively remove the rights of parents as the first educators of their children to choose the right moment to discuss love and human sexuality with their children. This will be overridden by the imposition of a curriculum not in conformity with Christian teaching (and that of many other faiths) and the right of parents to remove their children from such classes will be removed.
