SPREAD THE GOSPEL: DEVELOPING A MISSIONARY PARISH

The Diocesan Evangelisation Commission has spent the year of lockdown creating this programme and then piloting, reviewing, and amending it. It is a seven-week programme, running for one and half hours via Zoom on one evening a week. The dates will be Wednesday, April 21st and 28th, May 5th, May 12th and May 19th, June 9th and June 16th 2021. The programme will be delivered by members of the Evangelisation Commission and is open to all parishioners and clergy across the Archdiocese.

The programme has been designed to remind participants of the Great Commission and the basic Gospel message. It will cover a rudimentary history of the early church and will consider important messages from recent papal papers, how to give witness testimonies, evangelise non-church going Catholics with practical approaches and tools for building a parish team to evangelise.

SVP OUTREACH CENTRE TO OPEN IN CARDIFF

The Archdiocese of Cardiff is working with the Society of St Vincent de Paul (National and Local) to open a new outreach centre at the former church of St Clare's church in Ely, Cardiff. The Archdiocese is providing the building and its site with the S.V.P. investing a significant amount to upgrade the premises so that a variety of services can be offered to various groups of the vulnerable and needy. Please pray for the success of this initiative and for the people who they will ultimately help.

TACKLING FOOD POVERTY

Throughout the course of the Covid-19 crisis the parish has worked with the Diocese to support families in need. The pandemic has seen a reduction in the number of support services available and households losing sources of income through job loss. With the help of the Archdiocese since this crisis began we have been able to support over 100 families in the parish; and the work continues. This week we provided another £14,000 to our schools to help support families in need at this time through funding secured by the Diocese.

In addition to this work, the Archbishop's Food Voucher Scheme is now in its third round and has distributed a further £127,251 to help tackle food poverty within the Diocese. We still have a number of vouchers available for Tesco so if you would like to nominate any households in need at this time please contact Cathy in the parish office; or if you find yourself in need please reach out. We treat all cases with strict confidentiality.

EMERGING FROM LOCKDOWN

Throughout the coronavirus pandemic, the Welsh Government has worked closely with Faith groups through the Welsh Government Places of Worship Task and Finish Group. Fr Bernard Sixtus has represented the Catholic Church on this group. In an update received this week the Welsh Government are still reluctant to provide guidance as to how and when restrictions will be lifted regarding places of worship. The restrictions are what presently hold up the reopening of churches, with half of our churches scoring red in the assessments and others scoring amber (meaning modifications to the building are needed) we cannot reopen a number of churches at this time. St. David Lewis scored green hence the move to reopen. As we are now in a transition period for Welsh Government we will need to wait with patience until after Election Day to seek further clarity.
